


**Figure 18.1: Growth in Output from 2010- 2014**

The pattern of growth using the data from SciVal and InCites is similar.

In the data below the chart, note the rate of growth for New Zealand and Australia compared to China and the World, using SciVal data.



SciVal and InCites make changes to their publications dataset year on year. To evaluate an individual country's output, we compare it to the World average, using SciVal data from 2010-2014.
