The table below lists the top 10 in the world from [THE University Impact rankings](#) and from [Reuters Top 100: The World's Most Innovative Universities](#) and its [Asia Pacific Top 75 Most Innovative Universities](#). Universities that are part of state systems are not ranked separately. 30 universities are top ten in a THE or Reuters list. Another component of the ranking is bibliometrics, including total number of publications.. Although I could not replicate that search that THE used, I did do a modified search on industry and innovation in SciVal

**Columns 2 and 3** are THE's SDG 9 rankings for the world and Asia-Pac

- Six of the World's top 10 are Asian, with two each from Europe and North America
- The one U.S. top 10 is also top10 in Reuters top 10;
- Seven of the top 10 are in Reuters World listing
- Five top 10 Asia-Pac universities are from Korea, three from Japan and two from Taiwan. Monash, at 59 is the highest ranked Oceania ranking for this SDG
- Five of the top 10 Asian universities are on the Reuters World list
- Three are top 10 in Reuters Asia-Pac and all six are listed in Reuters Asia-Pac

**Columns 3 and 4** are Reuters Most Innovative Universities (October 2018) and Asia-Pac universities (June 2019)

- Nine of the World's top 10 are from the U.S. with one from Europe
- Seven of the World's most innovative universities did not participate in THE's rankings.
- Four of the Top 10 Asia-Pac universities are from Korea, three from Japan, two from China and one from Singapore.
- Five of Reuters Asia-Pac universities are not in THE's rankings.

**Column 5** ranks the universities in the dataset by Industry Income from the World Rankings.

- All 30 universities have an industry income rankings, ranking from 12 to over 500
- 11 of the 30 are in the top 100.
- Six are from Korea, and one each is from China, Taiwan, the U.K.. and U.S.
- Three Korean universities in the top 100 are also top 10 for SDG 9

**Column 6** ranks universities by publication output. SciVal only provides metrics for the top 100 in a category.

- Only 12 universities from our dataset were in SciVal's top 100
- Three of THE's world impact top 10 were on the list including one each from Korea, Canada and Finland
- Nine are from Reuters World list, with six of their world top 10 and three of their Asian top 10.
