

## APPENDIX 45-1: TOP Factor Integration into Clarivate Analytics' Master Journal List

In this article's conclusion, I recommend the creation of a product combining qualitative publishing requirements with bibliometric output metrics. It would support the growing emphasis on open scholarship with traditional metrics used to identify quality journals and would be useful to researchers and librarians. The integration of TOP Factor Standards into Clarivate Analytics' Master Journal List. is a step in that direction. Master Journal List includes all publications on the Web of Science Platform. It is a free tool. Registration is required to view the journal profiles. The Journal Impact Factor is included but not the supporting data.

Below is an example of TOP Factor Standard ratings in the Master Journal List record for *Public Administration Review* which is categorized under the Business & Management discipline in TOP Factor.



As shown in Table 45-4, not all TOP journals are in Web of Science. Those included may be categorized under different WOS subjects. Login is required to view the profile and determine if The Center for Open Science information is included in this record.



This record has both the Journal Impact Factor and Center for Open Science Information.
