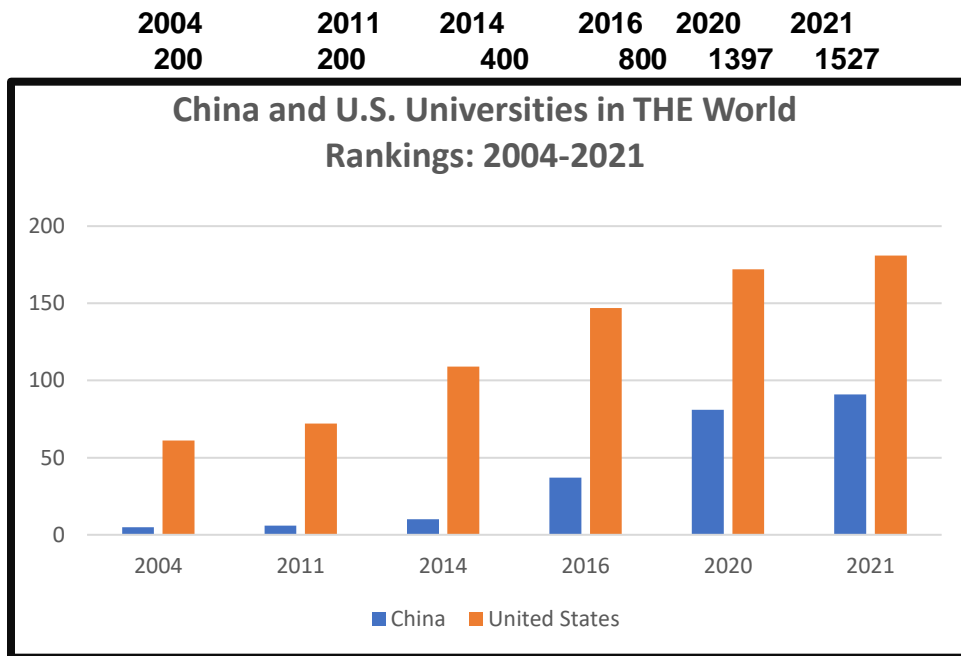


Table 5.2. – Universities ranked in the top 100 for each year. The U.S. peaked in 2011 as THE was changing methodology.

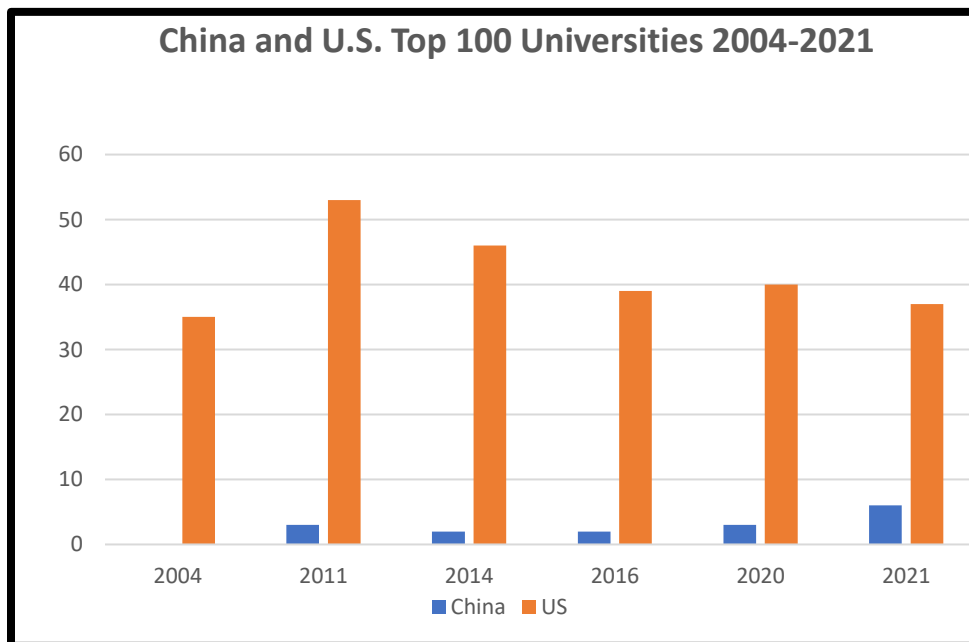
