The top 19 are ranked in at least one indicator top 10. Eight of the top 11 are top 10 World.

RANKINGS BY INDICATOR: 31 universities were in top ten rankings - since there were multiple universities in some categories.

RESEARCH - 8 of the top 10 are in the USA top 10; all are in the top 18. Three are public

EMPLOYABILITY - All top 10 are US Overall top 10.

Uses World Employer Reputation Survey with <100 U.S. institutions ranked

Learning Environment - 7 universities are ranked 1 and scored 100; the next 14 are ranked seven and scored
