CONCLUSION: Despite having unique indicators, no useful information is available for the ranked universities. The [Analytical Commentary](#) provides percentages by regions, but very few actual university rankings. Education lists top universities by region:

- Europe – Cambridge, École Poly Lausanne, and Lomonosov Moscow State University
- North America – MIT and Harvard
- Asia: Shanghai Jiao Tong, Peking, U Tokyo, and Chinese University Hong Kong.

Despite the unique indicators, MosIUR has a 90% overlap in top 10 with CWUR and 80% with THE and Shanghai (ARWU).

MosIUR has interesting and unique metrics. With the lack of scores and rankings for missions and indicators, I find this ranking of no use to any decision maker. It reported that it will be updating

some metrics for its next update and is developing a paid-access database with more specific information. (email from Xenia Zinoviev, 5 Aug 2021).
